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CHAPTER 1

What is it

A [Lago](#) plugin which allows you to deploy and test [oVirt](#) environments easily. It is mainly used by the [oVirt System tests](#) framework.

2.1 Installing lago-ost-plugin

2.1.1 RPM Based - Fedora 24+ / CentOS 7

1. Add the following repositories to a new file at `/etc/yum.repos.d/lago.repo` (If you installed lago before, the *lago* repository should be already configured):

For Fedora:

```
[lago]
baseurl=http://resources.ovirt.org/repos/lago/stable/0.0/rpm/fc$releasever
name=Lago
enabled=1
gpgcheck=0

[ovirt-ci-tools]
baseurl=http://resources.ovirt.org/repos/ci-tools/fc$releasever
name=oVirt CI Tools
enabled=1
gpgcheck=0
```

For CentOS:

```
[lago]
baseurl=http://resources.ovirt.org/repos/lago/stable/0.0/rpm/el$releasever
name=Lago
enabled=1
gpgcheck=0

[ovirt-ci-tools]
baseurl=http://resources.ovirt.org/repos/ci-tools/el$releasever
name=oVirt CI Tools
```

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```
enabled=1  
gpgcheck=0
```

For CentOS only, you will need **EPEL** repository:

```
$ sudo yum install epel-release
```

2. Install lago-ovirt (for Fedora use dnf instead):

```
$ sudo yum install lago-ovirt
```
